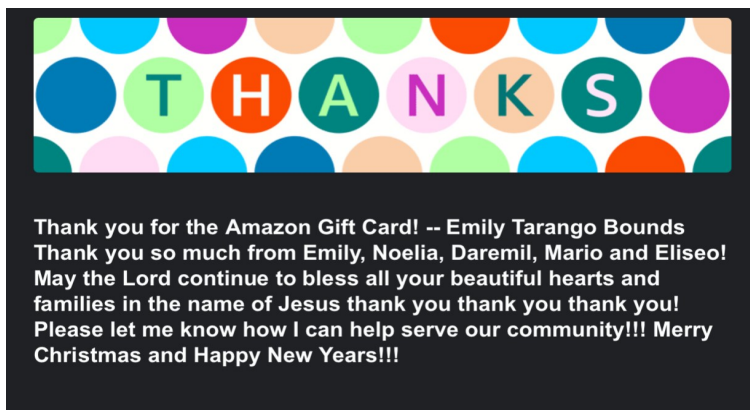
Let the Good Times Roll!

Marilyn Alt An Exemplary Soroptimist!

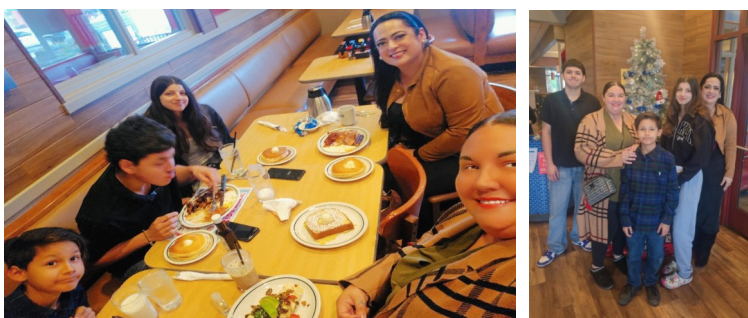
