

**How it works:** Clubs contribute a portion of their locally raised funds back to SIA—we recommend 10%. Gifts can be made alongside dues or anytime during the year.

#### **FOUNDERS PENNIES**

**Best for:** Clubs who want to uphold tradition in a symbolic, impactful way

**How it works:** Clubs give \$0.06 per member, multiplied by the number of years since SIA's founding (e.g., \$6.30/member in 2025). Typically given with annual dues.

#### THE LAUREL SOCIETY

Honors individuals' lifetime generosity

The Laurel Society is SIA's prestigious recognition program for donors who contribute gifts totaling \$1,000 or more. It's our way of celebrating donors whose generosity has made a transformative impact.

Cumulative giving of \$1,000+ earns you a place in the Laurel Society and you continue to gain levels of recognition as your lifetime giving increases. You receive a pin for each level and are invited to special events.

Every gift you make counts towards your Laurel Society recognition level. You also receive credit if anyone donates in your honor (including family, friends, or a club or region), if you raise funds for SIA through a peer-to-peer fundraiser, or if your employer matches your gift.


